has always promoted safety through education. However it wasn't until January 1988 the Rider Education Program began to gain momentum, with member participation increasing continuously through the years. There are now over 20,000 member participants in the program.

THE "RIDER ED" PROGRAM CONSIST OF FOUR LEVELS:

LEVEL I

"Safety By Commitment"

You may sign up for the Rider Education Program's Level 1 at any time. There are no prerequisites or minimums to meet. Simply bring your commitment to make riding safer for yourself and those with whom you ride.

LEVEL II

"Safety By Education"

To progress to this level, you must have signed on at Level I, achieved at least 5000 safe riding miles since becoming a GWRRA member and have taken an approved riding training course (rider) or an approved co-rider training course (Seminar or 2-up course) within the past two years.

LEVEL III (Certified Tour Rider/Co-Rider)

"Safety By Preparedness"

You must be current in Level II, have CPR or First Aid Training certification and carry a First Aid Kit on your bike.

LEVEL IV (Master Tour Rider / Co-rider)

"Safety by enhanced Preparedness & Experience"

You must be current and have a full year at Level III, have ridden at least 25,000 safe miles since joining GWRRA, have completed an approved Rider Training Course within the past year and must be certified in both CPR and First Aid. Co-riders must meet the same requirements with the substitution of a Co-rider Seminar or 2-up Riding Course.
